



REVIEWS – 2008 ARRIVO ROSATO DI NEBBIOLO

Seems funny to say 'hold off' on a rose, but I reckon this **Arrivo Rosato di Nebbiolo (2008)** will be a better drink given a few extra months in bottle - it will probably be at its best in late summer/autumn 2009 (which is probably the best time of the year to drink rose anyway).

I loved last year's release and I really like this too. It's a great style of rose. It's got lots of dry tannin, lots of fruity acidity, notes of nectarine and rose petals, dried herbs and chalk. Love the dry, grippy finish - it's a winner in my books.

Peter Godden and Sally McGill of Arrivo have a particular interest in the wines of Italy. This brick-reddish pink Adelaide Hills rose shows excellent nebbiolo traits. The complex aroma has notes of bitumen, some florals and spice. It tastes complex with a hint of strawberry, good mouth-filling texture, a firm dry finish and a long, savoury aftertaste. (13.5% alcohol; screw cap).

Arrivo Rosato di Nebbiolo 2008, 92 points

A savoury twist of maraschino cherry fruit and bright red apple fragrance. Nebbiolo chew on the palate makes a savoury impact, gently drying tannins fan out through the finish, bright acid too.

The northern Italian red grape nebbiolo has a distinctive character. As with most Italian red grapes, it makes good pink wine too. This Adelaide Hills pink nebbiolo has a nose of tar, blossom and spice, and the palate has a whisper of strawberry to it, along with attractive complexity, interesting texture, a firm finish and a lingering fragrant finish. 13.5% alcohol.

Kumquat peel tang, plus an earthiness and some nebbiolo florals. Attacks super-tight and dry, really powerful and chewy, yet refreshing with tight peel and pips. Might be too austere for some: it's really mouth-sucking and the fruit at the back is long. Serious rose.
